The Organizing Committee of the III International Congress The Child in the World Today and Tomorrow invites researchers, academics, health and education professionals, and students to participate with works developed in the area of health/education of children/youth and families, which may contribute to improving practices.

Contributions should be made through the submission of abstracts of original works. Selected abstracts will be presented at the congress.

Accepted and publicly presented works will be published in the congress abstract book (with ISBN).

Submitted abstracts should follow the thematic axes, which serve as a frame of reference rather than a thematic restriction.

ABSTRACTS

Authors can submit their works specifying the presentation format: oral communication or poster. However, the Scientific Committee may alter the presentation format.

- Abstracts can be submitted in Portuguese, Spanish, or English, using the template available for download on the congress website, and **should not exceed 250 words**.
- The title should not exceed **15 words**.
- Abstracts must follow the structure: introduction, objectives, methodology, results, and conclusion.

- The abstract should indicate the speaker, corresponding author, and email address for contact.
- Keywords: 3 to 5 (Portuguese and English), preferably MeSH/DeCS descriptors.
- Bibliographic references must adhere to the APA standard, 7th edition (**maximum of 5 references**).
- The **final submission date is May 26, 2025**.

PRESENTATION TIME

Oral Communication: 10 minutes.

Poster: 5 minutes.

EVALUATION

Acceptance or rejection of abstracts is decided by the Scientific Committee, with **notification by May 28, 2025**. The speaker must be registered by the final submission date (May 26, 2025).

The Scientific Committee will evaluate abstracts according to:

- a. Alignment with congress thematic axes
- b. Formatting
- c. Quality of information – Degree of innovation/contribution to scientific discussion
- d. Scientific rigor
- e. Abstract structure
- f. Overall quality

Accepted oral and poster **presentations must be submitted by June 1, 2025**, in PPT or PDF format, to the congress email.

AWARDS: A prize for the best Oral Communication and best Poster will be awarded to authors present at the closing ceremony.

Works involving authors who are members of the Organizing and/or Scientific Committees are not eligible for awards.

Any situation not covered will be analyzed by the Scientific Committee.
