

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMITTING ABSTRACTS

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Papers submitted in the categories of **oral presentations** and **posters** will be accepted and selected;
2. All papers selected by the scientific committee will be presented **either in person or online**;
3. Each oral presentation will have a **maximum duration of 10 minutes**, followed by a discussion period;
4. Posters, in e-poster format, will be presented for **3 minutes**, followed by a discussion;
5. Each applicant may submit up to **two papers as first author**, provided they are registered for the Congress;
6. Papers will be **assessed by a scientific committee**, which will issue a decision against which no appeal may be lodged.
7. Papers must be submitted in abstract format (in **Portuguese or English**) via email to: congressoreabilitar2026@gmail.com
8. Prizes will be awarded for the best oral presentation and poster.
9. The final full article must be submitted to the ***Rehabilitation Nursing Journal*** (RNJ) by **16 October 2026**, to the journal's address and in accordance with the author template and the journal's publication guidelines. The journal will inform the corresponding author of the results of the blind peer review carried out by the reviewers.

IMPORTANT DATES

- Abstract Submission – by **2 September 2026**
- Notification to Authors – by **5 September 2026**

STRUCTURE OF THE ABSTRACT

Abstracts must **not exceed 300 words (1.800 characters)**, including spaces).

If the abstract is based on a **primary or secondary study**, it must include the following sections:

- **Introduction**, including the main objective
- **Methods**
- **Results**
- **Conclusions**
- **Keywords** (maximum of 5 words)

If resulting from a **Theoretical-Practical Proposal** | **Project Assignment** must include:

• Introduction • State of the Art and New Perspectives • Implications for Clinical Practice • Future Perspectives • Final Considerations	• Context and Justification • Objectives • Project Description and Implementation • Results/impact and Replication Potential • Final Considerations
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Bibliographical references must be presented in accordance with **APA** style.

When submitting abstracts, authors must use the **template** provided by the **Organising Committee**.
